Wells Plastics has performed a full and detailed risk assessment of all of its operations in relation to COVID 19 and its workforce in line with the Health and Safety Executive Guidelines and where ever possible provided solutions to reduce further the risk to all employees, site visitors and service providers within the supply chain.

Covid-19 is an infectious disease caused by a newly discovered coronavirus that has resulted in a global pandemic. Covid-19 causes harm to people by affecting lungs and airways. Most people infected with the Covid-19 virus will experience mild to moderate respiratory illness and recover without requiring special treatment. Older people, and those with underlying medical problems like cardiovascular disease, diabetes, chronic respiratory disease, and cancer are more likely to develop serious illness, even fatality.
